Much more information is available about historic preservation and the maintenance of historic building fabric than be presented in this preservation plan. A number of sources of additional reference information are listed below.

Important sources include the National Park Service (NPS) website, *www.nps.gov*, and the website of its Cultural Resources Division, *www.cr.nps.gov*. At those sites, technical information about preserving historic buildings is available under headings such as “Heritage Preservation Services” and “Technical Preservation Services.” Printed versions of these materials are also available for purchase. Key reference materials posted on the National Park Service websites include:

Preservation Briefs – The NPS has published the *Preservation Briefs* since 1975, and over forty of them have now been created. Each of these briefs addresses a specific preservation issue. They are designed to be easy-to-read guides on preserving, rehabilitating and restoring historic buildings. *Preservation Briefs* 1-42 are available on-line. *Preservation Briefs* are included in the list below.

Preservation Tech Notes – The *Preservation Tech Notes* series was initiated by the NPS in 1984. This series provides practical information on traditional practices and new techniques for sensitively maintaining and preserving cultural resources. Over 45 of these *Preservation Tech Notes* are available to the public, and many of them are available on-line. These publications are more specific technical guides for preservation professionals such as architects, contractors, and maintenance personnel, as well as for owners and developers of historic properties.

National Register Bulletins – The NPS bulletin series provides guidance in the documentation, evaluation, and nomination of historic sites to the National Register. The series is divided into four sections: The Basics, Property Types, Technical Assistance, and General Guidance. Several additional brochures about National Register programs are also available.
