


2009 Graduation Initiative Goals

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



4-Year Graduation Rate for First-Time, Full-Time Freshmen




It starts with taking 15 units per semester.

Finishing in four years saves money, can result in better grades, and gets your career started sooner. Since 120 units are the minimum required for a bachelor's degree, it means taking at least 15 units per semester.

Improvements in Advising

- How do we increase the percentage of students who establish a degree plan before they begin taking classes?
- Can we improve the integration of data systems with advising to more effectively share information about student progress?
- What structural changes must occur to end "pinball advising," where students are bounced from office to office in pursuit of guidance, permissions or clear answers?
